THE WELCOME HOUSE PROGRAM OF RECOVERY



The Welcome House is a not-for-profit, sober living, recovery program (incorporated in 1971) with “the sole purpose of educating and rehabilitating the adult male alcoholic/addict” and “the expressed mission of returning the individual to productive society free of alcohol and drug abuse.”

Welcome House can accommodate 80 men and is currently operating at capacity. The program is based upon “12-step addiction recovery programs” and includes both Alcoholics Anonymous and Narcotics Anonymous.

- Structured Community Environment
- Curfew
- Meeting & Counseling Requirements (On-site)
- Random UA and BA Testing
- Focus on Personal Responsibility & Accountability
- Do Not Drink or Use (Zero Tolerance)
- Go to Meetings
- Get a Sponsor
- Get a Job
- Pay Rent
- 120 Day Minimum (Recommended)
- Emphasis on Building Relationships in the Recovery Community

“Welcome House is committed to providing a high-quality, moral, and open residential program to recovering alcoholics and drug-addicted men facing the difficult transition from treatment, incarceration, and homelessness to reintegration back into society as productive citizens.”

ADMISSION

- A [personal interview is required for admission](#). You may complete the application form beforehand by downloading it from our website; or complete it when you arrive for your interview.
- A photo ID is required.
- The first week’s rent, \$154, is required to move in.
- You must be at least 21 years of age.
- To schedule an interview, call (816) 472-0760, Monday-Friday between 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

RENT

- Rent is \$22 per day or \$154 per week.
- Meals are included.
