In 1970, a group of men formed an Alcoholics Anonymous group and called themselves Performance III or "P III." These were straight talking, no nonsense men who had surmounted many challenges and found their own sobriety.

The men of P III were inspired to help other men in their recovery and began renting rooms in rundown hotels in downtown Kansas City. They passed the hat at AA meetings to pay the bills. In 1971, they secured permanent housing to provide a clean and safe space for other men to find sobriety: Welcome House.

In its 46 years, Welcome House has become a vital resource in the recovery community. As in the beginning, residents still pay a subsidized rent so others can receive the support they desperately need.

 - helped 15,000+ men seeking sobriety.
